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## 3. Rules and Regulations

The Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025 will follow the ISSF and ASC Rules and General Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website <a href="www.issf-sports.org">www.issf-sports.org</a> and <a href="https://www.asia-shooting.org">https://www.asia-shooting.org</a>

## Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment control will be conducted according to ISSF rules, using approved calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, the athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

### Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and affixing a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid, except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes who wish to replace registered jackets or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

#### **Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing**

If one rifle jacket or trousers panel tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. The athlete must be disqualified if two or more panels fail (DSQ).

#### Air or CO2 Cylinder

The athlete must ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

#### **Equipment Control**

Equipment control will be open to the athletes as scheduled in the competition program.

# 5. Participation

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must be registered officially by their federation.

ASC Member Federation may enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals other two (2) can only compete for the ranking point. Two (2) Mixed Teams in respective Mixed Team events but only one (1) of them can go (highest ranking team) to compete in the Final for the medals and one (1) Team in the respective Team events (ASC Rules 7.6.2).

The ASC member federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes.

All athletes participating must have an ISSF ID number. All athletes without the ISSF ID numbers are not allowed to participate in the competitions.

#### **Maximum Entry**

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each Asian Shooting Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges/firing points. If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first-come, first-served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the OC will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

## 6. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted. All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

## **Preliminary Entries**

ASC Member Federations entering the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025 ISSF Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <a href="https://shootingsportscloud.com">https://shootingsportscloud.com</a>. The Preliminary Entry Deadline is 15 DEC 2024.

#### **Final Entries**

ASC Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <a href="https://shootingsportscloud.com">https://shootingsportscloud.com</a>. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is 10 JAN 2025.

#### **Late Entries**

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **05 FEB 2025**.

**Important Note:** Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names/athletes within an event
- b) Change of status ("Medal" athlete to "Ranking Point Only" or "Out of Competition" athlete) within an event

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from 06 FEB 2025 onwards, may not participate.

## **Entry Confirmation upon arrival**

All Team Leaders of the ASC Member Federation Delegations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

### **Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline**

From 06 FEB 2025 onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- b) Status exchange of a registered athlete for competing in the Final for Medals and of a "RPO" athlete can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event

#### Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline 10 JAN 2025 must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and officials entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

#### **Entry Fees**

### **Unofficial Training Fee**

The shooting ranges will be open for unofficial training with costs. The reservation for unofficial training from 09 FEB to 21 FEB 2024 should be made one (1) day before you request to the financial team in the shooting range, and make payment in USD cash only, the fees will be USD 20 per person per lane for two (2) hours.

#### **Payment of Entry Fees**

All payments must be made to the Organizing Committee, not the ISSF or ASC. ASC Member federations are requested to pay entry fees and firearm permit fees by bank transfer in US Dollars Currency (USD) by 21 JAN 2025.

As for bank transfer, please identify clearly which country or federation is submitting the payment and send copies of the transfer voucher to the Organizing Committee by 21 JAN 2025 for the OC to notify the federation of the net amount received correctly.

Participants should be paid all the bank charges. Any balance for entry fees transferred must be affected by USD, Cash only at the shooting range upon arrival. No traveller's checks or credit/debit cards will be accepted.

Accreditation for final registration and payment is advisable to be made by one (1) Representative per ASC Member Federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to the representative to bring with him/her to the Entry Confirmation.

#### 7. Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025 (Athletes, Team Officials, ASC Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and who have a photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Accreditation Office at the shooting range. Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

## 9. Immigration and Customs Requirements

OC recommends you register the following applications for smooth entry at the immigration through the EDI system or custom manually. The Thai EDI system can be accessed at <a href="https://www.mfa.go.th">www.mfa.go.th</a>.

#### **VISA**

Anyone who requires an Entrance Visa to Thailand should contact the Thai Embassy or Consulate at your location to obtain the Visa before arrival in Thailand. You can also get an Electronic Visa on Arrival (E VOA) for Thailand.

ISSF Member Federation that requires an Official Invitation Letter to apply for a Visa, please fill in the enclosed **VISA Support form (Annex 7)** and return it together with scanned copies of valid passport for all Visa applicants to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but not later than **08 JAN 2025**. This form must be typed and readable on a PC. Please submit the form completed, signed, and stamped by the federation. Please do not change or use the other forms. Incomplete or incorrect forms will be returned, and unprocessed.

#### **Gun Permits**

The ASC Member Federations must declare all firearms brought into Bangkok, Thailand for the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025 in advance. The federation must fill in the **Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8)**, sign, and stamp it, and return it to the Organizing Committee by email as soon as possible but NOT later than **25 DEC 2024**.

All delegations must show Annex 8 (in triplicate) to the Customs authorities for the firearms and ammunition verification at the Suvarnabhumi International Airport. Please bring your local import and export firearm licenses

It is strictly prohibited by the local security code that any athlete or delegation take any firearm for themselves out of the airport or to the hotel.

Preliminary hotel Reservations must be affected by 08 NOV 2024.

Final Hotel Reservation must be affected by 08 JAN 2025.

The reservation will be considered on a "first come – first served" basis once the OC receives the duly filled **Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 5)**, not the Preliminary Hotel Form. Then the OC will inform the federation of the hotel name and send the Proforma Invoice if requested. All participating federations are requested to wire a minimum of 80% of the accommodation of the total accommodating costs to the OC account by **21 JAN 2025**.

However, OC may not guarantee accommodation if the minimum of 80% of total accommodation costs are not paid by the deadline.

In case of cancellation after the Final Hotel Reservation, on **08 JAN 2025**, the Organizing Committee will charge the full costs based on your reservation (for the total room and nights).

All extra charges such as telecommunications, mini bar, extra meals, laundry, etc. at the official hotels must be paid directly to the hotel at check-out. Please note that if any team/federation books accommodation directly, no official recognition would be given, and the Organizing Committee would provide no official transportation.

No payment to the ISSF, ASC or the Hotel – Payment must be made directly to the Organizing Committee.

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## 11. Travel and Transportation

Airport pick-up from Suvarnabhumi Airport - Transportation to the Official Hotel (and return for departure)

Participants will be transported directly from Suvarnabhumi Airport (BKK) to NSSAT (Huamak) Shooting Ranges to store the guns and ammunition, then taken to the official hotels. The airport pick-up/drop-off transportation is free of charge, from the official arrival to departure day.

#### **Local Transportation – Shuttle Service**

For the delegation that accommodates at the Official Hotels through the OC, a free shuttle service will be provided between the hotels and the shooting range from 09 FEB to 22 FEB 2025, ONLY. A timetable of the transportation between the hotel and the shooting range will be available at the hotel information desk.

Any delegation accommodating at non-official hotels must make all their local transportation (airport-hotel-shooting range) by themselves regardless of the entry fee payment. This will apply to any delegation who book the official hotel by themselves, not by the OC.

## 12. Competition-Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

### **Technical Meeting**

The Technical Meeting will take place on 11 FEB 2025, in the 10-meter Meeting Room.

The ASC Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding the Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

#### **Ammunition**

There is no limitation on the quantity of ammunition that participants can bring to Thailand for training and competition during the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025. The amount of all ammunition brought to Thailand must be declared to the Organizing Committee within the deadline (06 JAN 2025).

#### 13. Ceremonies

#### **Opening and Closing Ceremony**

The opening Ceremony will take place on 10 FEB 2025. The time and place will be noticed at a later stage. No Closing Ceremony will not be held.

#### **Victory Ceremony**

Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after each Final Hall (see also: Final Competition Schedule at the later stage). During the ceremonies, the athletes who

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receive awards are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

### **National Flags and Anthems**

The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations. OC will arrange them in advance and verify them through the Team representative at the shooting range.

### 14. Weather Information

During the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025, the temperature is expected to be 30°C to 38°C. Raining is expected on some days. The average sunlight is 12 hours/per day.

### 15. Media Relations

All Media representatives must register for the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025 by using the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 9).

A Media office will be available at the shooting range during the Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup 2025, equipped with internet, telephone, and fax connection. No press conferences are planned.

## 16. Industry Service

The Organizing Committee will provide industry services and displays or exhibitions wishing to make them at the shooting range. The industry or company wishing to use a booth at their own cost for exhibition or product sales is required to contact the OC directly for further details and costs.
