The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the Asian Shotgun Cup is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day).

The latest Schedule updates **and other technical information** will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

### 3. Rules and Regulations

The Asian Shotgun Cup will be conducted according to the to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations. Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations using instruments and devices approved by the ISSF.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS / Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the Asian Shooting Confederation to supervise the Asian Cup. Qualified Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.



## Shotgun Equipment

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition, if available.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

## Cartridge Controls

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ), in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 (a).

During Finals all finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists and their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Finals (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals.

## Colored Wads

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used.

**If an athlete, uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).**

## Equipment Control

Equipment control will be open to competitors as scheduled in the Program of the competition.

## Competition Rules for Double-Trap

The Rules 9.9.1 and 9.15.2.5 are outlined below as per ISSF Shotgun Rules:



### **Rule 9.9.1 - Conduct of a Round of Double Trap:**

- a) Each squad member, with sufficient ammunition and all equipment necessary to complete the round, must occupy a shooting station in the order shown on the scorecard;
- b) The sixth athlete must stand in the marked area behind Station 1 (Station 6) ready to move to Station 1 as soon as the first athlete has shot at a regular double and the results are known; and
- c) The Referee must ensure that all preliminary procedures are completed (names, numbers, Assistant Referees, test firing, viewing of targets etc.) give the command "START."

### **Rule 9.15.2.5 - Double Trap Shoot-Off Procedures:**

- a) Shoot-offs will be conducted on scheme "C" (machines 7 & 9).
- b) All tied shooters will in turn, one behind the other, starting on Station 1, shoot at a regular double in the order that will be decided by the Jury by drawing of lots;
- c) At Station 1 only, the shooters must be permitted to see one (1) regular Double, before the first shooter starts;
- d) After the Referee declares "**START**" the first shooter must load and shoot at the Double. He must then leave the Station and go to stand **a minimum of 1 metre** immediately behind the next Station. The remainder of the shooters who have yet to shoot on that Station must then stand in a line behind the first athlete;
- e) All shooters remaining in the tie must in turn do likewise;
- f) The first shooter must not move on to a Station until the Referee commands "**START**";
- g) The athlete(s) who hit the highest number of targets on the respective Station are the winners of the shoot-off and qualify for the Final;
- h) This process will continue until all ties are broken;

## **4. Participation**

### **Individual Events**

Each ASC Member Federation can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for Ranking Points, according to the ISSF General Regulations and ASC General Regulations.

### **Mixed Team Events**

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event, but only (1) of them can go (highest ranking team) to compete in the Final for the medals according to ASC General Regulations, article 7.6.2.

In the Mixed team competition, the top four (4) teams will be awarded According ASC General Regulations, article 15.5.2 as follows, after qualification to the medal matches.

- 1+2 for gold and silver medal match.
- 3+5 for bronze medal match one (1).



4+6 for bronze medal match two (2).

Two bronze Medals will be awarded.

### Team events

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes (Trap Team Men, Trap Team Women, Skeet Team Men, Skeet Team Women).

### Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each Asian Shotgun Cup event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF / ASC Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

### ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the Asian Shotgun Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

## 5. Entry Process

**Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the established deadlines.**

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to ISSF Headquarters. Entry Forms are provided, but ASC Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service. All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").



## Preliminary Entries

ASC Member Federations entering the Asian Shotgun Cup must submit the Preliminary Entries not later than **21 JUL 2024**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1) and return it by email to [marco.mori@issf-sports.org](mailto:marco.mori@issf-sports.org), or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

## Final Entries

ASC Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ISSF HQ. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) is **21 AUG 2024**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 3) and return them by email to [marco.mori@issf-sports.org](mailto:marco.mori@issf-sports.org), or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

## Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which is **17 SEP 2024**.

**Important Note:** Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of Status (Asian Shotgun Cup athlete ↔ RPO only athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **18 SEP 2024** onwards, may not participate.

## Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ASC Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

## Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **18 SEP 2024** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

## Cancellation

Any ASC Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (**21 AUG 2024**) must pay applicable cancellation fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

## Entry Fee

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

**The Entry Fee includes only one (1) round of PET (For the Unofficial Training rounds and for any extra rounds of PET, the cost must be paid to the OC).**

### **Payment of Entry Fees**

All payments **MUST BE** cash in Euro / US Dollars only to the Organizing Committee upon arrival at the shooting complex. Payment using either credit or debit cards or travelers or bank cheques **will NOT be accepted**. Upon request, invoice can be sent for payment through bank transfer. **Any charge**, deducted by bank shall be collected from the federation making payment through bank transfer.

Federations are requested to clearly assign payment to Organizing Committee in order to afford credit to the federation.

### **Accreditation Process**

All delegation members involved in the Asian Shotgun Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media representatives) must have accreditations that clearly identify its holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for delegation members registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Asian Shotgun Cup Accreditation Office.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

## **6. Shooting Range**

The Asian Shotgun Cup will take place at the Asanov Shooting Club, Almaty, Kazakhstan

The shooting range has 5 combined ranges for Trap / Double Trap / Skeet. The shooting range is equipped with Nasta machines and Range Master Company acoustic release system. The Skeet ranges operate with acoustic release system. All ranges are equipped with Range master Company electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north.

The targets used for Asian Shotgun Cup Shotgun are Nasta standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

**9. Travel and Transportation**

**Travel – Arrival**

All participating federations are encouraged to book flights for two destinations: Nursultan Nazarbayev International Airport (Nur-Sultan-NQZ) and Almaty International Airport (Almaty-ALA). There will be **NO ASSISTANCE** at customs and immigration for participants arriving at other airports.

**Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and back for departure)**

All delegates will be received at a welcome desk at the airport by the OC at the Almaty airport and necessary arrangements will be made for the transfers to the hotels.

Service duration: From the airport it would take about 40/50 minutes to the hotels.

**Local Transportation – Shuttle Service**

Local transportation between the official hotels and the shooting range will be arranged by the Organizing Committee during training and competition days only (**21 SEP - 29 SEP 2024**).

Distance from the hotels to the ranges is approximately 30 to 35 kilometers and takes 30 to 45 minutes to reach there.

The bus schedules for transportation from the hotels to the ranges and back will be available at the Info Centre and in the official hotels.

**10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range**

**Technical Meeting**

The Technical Meeting will take place on **21 SEP 2024** for Trap and **25 SEP 2024** for Skeet at the shooting range.

Each participating ASC Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Asian Shotgun Cup. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.





## Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

The Arms and Ammunition will be stored at the Range in the armory and will not be allowed to be taken out of the shooting range premises at any time. Upon arrival at Almaty International Airport, after checking through customs, all firearms will be transported by the Organizing Committee directly to the Asanov Shooting Club. The Arms and Ammunition will be stored at the Range in the armory and will be not allowed to taken out of the shooting range premises at any time as per the Firearm (Weapon) laws of Kazakhstan. All participants are kindly requested to complete and return the Firearm and Ammunition Form on time.

### Note:

**In order to obtain permit for each athlete we need a passport scan copy of group leader (or any responsible person) coming at specific dates. In case of two arrivals the details of two responsible personnel must be provided.**

**Finally, it is NOT ALLOWED to bring the cartridges to Kazakhstan.**

## 11. Ceremonies

### Opening and Closing Ceremony

Both the Opening and Closing Ceremonies will take place; the detailed information will be provided during Technical Meeting.

### Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after the end of each Final (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).



## **Flags and Anthems**

The Organizing Committee does not need flags and anthems from the delegations.

## **12. Weather Information**

During the late July and early August, the weather in Almaty is very pleasant with sunshine and clear sky. The temperature is expected to be between 20°C - 25°C during the day, and 11°C - 15°C during the night.

## **13. Media Relations**

All Media representatives must register for the Asian Shotgun Cup Shotgun competition by using the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 9).
